Students choose an act that they want to perform in front of the entire school and at an evening performance for parents. We've had a variety of performances in the past: dancers, singers, and magicians, just to name a few. With so many students who want to participate in the talent show, we have auditions. Three judges rate the performances and choose which students will perform in the Talent Show.



A lunchtime Talent Show meeting (12:15 to 1:00 PM) will be held on Thursday, February 23 for interested students. Students will receive a permission slip, a list of do's and don'ts, and helpful tips and hints. Signed permission slips are due by March 13 at 2:30 PM.

Auditions will be held on March 16, 3:30 to 5:00 PM. Students will be given an audition time slot. We are asking that students do not stay after school; instead, plan to arrive 10 minutes before your time slot.

Want to be an MC for the show? Students can audition for one of two MC slots. We'll have scripts for MC auditions.

The lineup will be posted outside the auditorium on March 17. A lunchtime meeting (12:15 to 12:30 PM) for acts in the show will be held on March 21. Music is due at this time. All music must be on a CD labeled with student's first and last name, name of song, and type of act

The Talent Show will be on March 23, 5:30 to 7:00 PM. Acts need to be at school by 5:15 PM

All-school shows will be held during the school day on March 24. There will be two time slots to sign up for.

Student Council will be selling flowers and water, and a donation box will be out for the Leukemia Lymphoma Society. A representative will be present to answer questions about the organization.
