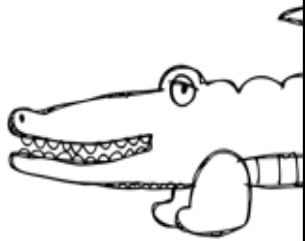


# The A to Z of Kindergarten Readiness
