The adventuring heroes work as a team to talk their way out of jams, solve challenging puzzles, and navigate ancient monster lairs, gaining treasure, friendship, and advancing their character's personal story in the tale that they make together. Engaging students outside of the classroom is a difficult task. Our programs offer kids a completely non-digital activity which is incredibly rewarding and fun. At the same time, kids learn to flex their imagination in a social setting. We integrate education into the system, creating a cooperative storytelling experience that builds friendships and critical thinking that they can carry with them both in and out of the classroom. League of Wayfinders programs are much smaller than the traditional after school program, with groups ranging from 4-6 kids per instructor, allowing for much fuller engagement and one-on-one time with instructors, and facilitating more engaging stories based on the children's needs.
