

Disney's The Lion King Costumes

Costumes are homework. We are talking about how to create simple costumes that reflect the character kids are portraying. I want to encourage dark pants on the bottom. I think African designs or animal designs drawn on a white t-shirt would work well for simplicity, function and coolness. The auditorium will be smoking hot, and the players will be moving throughout the performance, and large bulky costumes will inhibit other's movements on stage.

We have talked about puppets and masks in school. We are talking about 3 types of masks that can be used. An above head mask, a staff mask and a medallion mask. If your child decides to create a mask for her head, please, make sure it does not cover the face. It should sit on the top of the head. Examples will (or have) been shown to the students.
