Our programs are much smaller than traditional enrichment programs, with groups ranging from 4-6 kids per instructor. Smaller classes allow for fuller involvement and one-on-one time with instructors, which helps develop a more immersive story based on the children's specific needs. Whatever they would like to explore, we provide a safe and entertaining space to adventure.

While exploring their characters, kids learn to flex their imagination in a social setting. We integrate education into the system, creating a cooperative storytelling experience that exercises critical thinking and fosters teamwork, skills that they can carry with them both in and out of the classroom.
